



FAQs for Discovery Link and Enrichments during a strike

Central based Extended Learning and Community Schools staff, including site-based Program Specialists, will be supporting students and schools during the regular school day. Communication may be delayed. Each site will identify an alternative staff member to monitor calls and emails prior to the start of programming.

1. Will Discovery Link and Enrichments be open during a strike?

Discovery Link and enrichments will continue their regularly scheduled programming hours. Enrichments that are led by teachers may be rescheduled in the absence of available sub coverage. Program Specialists will communicate directly with families.

2. What if my child's school closes? What does that mean for Discovery Link and Enrichments?

In the event the Superintendent determines it is necessary to close a school, Discovery Link and Enrichments will be cancelled.

3. Will I be charged if I choose not to send my child to programming during a strike?

If you choose not to send your child to programming, we will credit your account within a month. We will need an email confirmation on non-attendance days sent directly to your child's Program Specialist at site. In the event of low attendance for enrichments, we will try to work with community partners to offer an additional class.

4. What if I have CCAP and choose not to send my child?

We are unable to adjust parental fees for days not attended. If you have questions, please reach out directly to your CCAP caseworker.

5. Can I change my child's schedule?

Due to licensing ratios and staffing schedules, we will not be able to accommodate any schedule changes during a strike. Drop-ins will not be accepted.

6. If my child currently does not attend Discovery Link, can I enroll my child in Discovery Link?

Due to licensing ratios, staffing schedules, and applicable waitlists, we will not be able to process new enrollments at this time. Drop-ins will not be accepted.

7. What if my child's school is scheduled for a camp day during the strike?

At this time we are planning to proceed with the camps scheduled on 2/15 at Inspire and Sandoval. We will notify families 48 hours in advance if a cancellation is necessary. Families who choose to cancel camp registration will receive a credit on their account. Please email your Program Specialist by Wed. 2/13 to cancel.

Discovery Link ECE Information

In alignment with the District's cancellation of all ECE classes if a strike should occur, *we will also be cancelling ECE Discovery Link*. All of our full-time staff will be out supporting DPS schools and students during the regular school day. As with the regular school day, ECE Discovery Link requires a specific level of licensing. Therefore, we will not be able to offer ECE camp days as we are not able to meet those staffing requirements. Tuition will be waived for any days programming is cancelled. Your account will be credited for the days of a strike.
